Notice of Race & Entry Form

1. Organisation.

- 1.1. The 2017 June Series is organised by Clwb Hwyllo Pwllheli Sailing Club (CHPSC).

2. Rules.

- 2.1. The Racing will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Clwb Hwyllo Pwllheli Sailing Club's Sailing Instructions 2017.
- 2.2. IRC rules part A, B & C shall apply to IRC racing.
- 2.3. Handicapping by RYA National Handicap for Cruisers (NHC) Club series shall apply.
- 2.4. In the event of conflict, the CHPSC 2017 Sailing Instructions will prevail. This changes RRS 63.7

3. RYA Racing Charter

- 3.1. Clwb Hwyllo Pwllheli Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter which requires both competitors to sail, and organisers to provide, racing in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing) or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter.

4. Entries, Registration & Eligibility

- 4.1. 2017 June Series is an open event and entries are invited from CHPSC members and non-members.
- 4.2. Competitors must complete the entry form and pay the race fee to CHPSC or by using the Annual Entry Form [here](#)
- 4.3. The 2017 June Series will provide racing for the following classes of yachts and the Class divisions will be as follows: -

Class	Flag	IRC – NHC Club
One	numeral pennant 1 (White with Red spot)	All IRC & NHC
Three	numeral pennant 3 (Red, White and Blue vertical stripes)	All IRC & NHC Club White Sail Class

- 4.4. These ranges may be changed at the discretion of the sailing committee
- 4.5. Class Flags may be flown from the backstay of each competing yacht.
- 4.6. Yachts shall belong to or be chartered to and be under the control of a member of a yacht club affiliated to the RYA or other equivalent national authority.
- 4.7. Entries shall be made on the Official Entry Form which is attached to this Notice of Race and this should be posted in the official race entry box located next to the official Notice Board in the entrance hallway of CHPSC.
- 4.8. The entry form must be accompanied with the appropriate entry fee and for IRC entries a copy of a valid IRC Certificate.
- 4.9. Entries will, in exceptional circumstances, be accepted, at the Race Officers discretion, by VHF for yachts arriving from other clubs.
- 4.10. The Race Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and/or to ask any boats to complete further undertaking or declarations before accepting their entry.
- 4.11. Registration can be done at the CHPSC club room. Race packs are available for printing from the CHPSC web page.



5. Measurement

- 5.1. For IRC competitors a valid and current IRC rating certificates must be presented with the race entry form.
- 5.2. All boats are welcome. The race series will be dual scored using the IRC and NHC Handicapping by RYA National Handicap for Cruisers (NHC). This is to encourage boats that do not hold a valid IRC certificate to race. (with an allowance made for non spinnaker entries). This race will form part of the Pwllheli June series 2017. Boats not holding a handicap will have one calculated by the sailing committee.

6. Changes in Sailing Instructions

- 6.1. Any change to Sailing Instructions will be posted by 08.30hrs on the day it will take effect and may be repeated on the Clwb Hwyllo Pwllheli Sailing Club Web Page.

7. Schedule of Races.

- 7.1. The race schedule will be as shown on the front page of this Notice of Race.
- 7.2. The type of racing on Saturday 10th June will be a shuffle race and Sunday 11th June will be the "Tremadog Triangle Challenge" A schedule of marks, fixed courses and charts are provided in the CHPSC 2017 Race Pack available on the CHPSC web page.
- 7.3. The type of racing for the second weekend (17th&18thJune) will be two round the cans races on each day and the course will be announced by the Race Officer and will be based on the schedule of marks provided in the CHPSC 2017 Race Pack available on the CHPSC web page. The Race Officer will decide if there is to be one start for all classes or separate starts for each class or a group of classes. This will be announced by VHF (Channel 17) and flags.

8. The racing

- 8.1. The races will be in accordance with the General Sailing Instructions [here](#)
- 8.2. Pwllheli Shuffle Race
 - (a) The start line will be a transit between the ODM and Pwllheli bridge ...see position on PSC list of marks 2017.
 - (b) When starting, the start line may be passed through in any direction and the time recorded by each participating boat. Engines must be turned off 4 minutes before starting.
 - (c) The List of Marks for the shuffle will be published on the PSC website on Friday night by 8pm, emailed to the priority racing list, and posted on the PSC racing facebook page. Each of the published PSC racing marks must be passed within one boat length, with the time and sequence of mark passing noted.
 - (d) Finish line is a transit between the PSC bridge and the ODM (as per start line) This may be in any direction. Again note the time.
 - (e) After racing text boat name with start and finish time to 07966490414.
- 8.3. Tremadog Triangle Challenge
 - (a) Using the club start/finish line as above, the course is set as follows: start 2(p) 8(p) 10(p) finish ..the anticlockwise course or start 10(s) 8(s) 2(s) finish ..the clockwise course
 - (b) Record times and text boat names and time to 07966490414 this challenge will be scored using NHC and will run until the end of the autumn series. Times recorded on Sunday 11th will form part of the June series in conjunction with the shuffle race.

9. Time of Starts

- 9.1. 10th and 11th June starts will be on a self start basis and will have a start window of between 09:00 and 11:30 (Saturday) 10:00-11:30 (Sunday)
- 9.2. Racing on 17th an 18th June will start with traditional bridge starts at 1300 both days.
- 9.3. The start may be broadcast on VHF Channel 17



10. Risk Statement

- 10.1. RRS Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."
- 10.2. Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
 - (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
 - (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission;
 - (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
 - (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
 - (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
 - (g) They are responsible for ensuring that their boat is equipped and seaworthy so as to be able to face extremes of weather; that there is crew sufficient in number, experience and fitness to withstand such weather; and that the safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and is familiar to the crew.
 - (h) Their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £3,000,000 against third party claims.

11. Safety

- 11.1. All yachts shall comply with ISAF offshore safety regulations Category 4.

12. Personal Safety

RRS 1.2, 40 shall apply and it is the sole responsibility of the skipper to ensure that Life Jackets/Harness lines are carried for each member of the crew.
