Saturday - St Tudwal's Islands Race will be a long bay race for the ISORA fleet with a shorter race for the IRC fleet. The course will be announced by the Race Officer.

Sunday – Gwyndaf Cup - PSC Bridge Start with two 'Windward Leeward' style round the Cans Racing using fixed courses.

This is an Open Event - all competitors and their crews (guests) will become temporary members of PSC for the duration of the event.

Notice of Race & Entry Form

1. Organisation.

- 1.1. The 2011 St Tudwal's Island Race and Gwyndaf Cup are organised by the Sailing Committee of Pwllheli Sailing Club (PSC) and ISORA.

2. Rules.

- 2.1. The event will be sailed under the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the prescriptions of the RYA, The Pwllheli Sailing Club's Sailing Instructions 2011 and this NOTICE OF RACE and the (ISORA) Irish Sea Offshore Racing Association 2011 Series Notice Of Race & General Conditions.
- 2.2. IR2000 rules part 1, 2 & 3 shall apply, except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.3. In the event of conflict, the PSC 2011 Sailing Instructions will prevail. This changes RRS 63.7
- 2.4. IRC rule 14.1 is amended to the extent that powered winches or other sail or rig handling equipment may be used by all boats. This amends RRS52.
- 2.5. Competitors should note PSC implements the RYA Racing Charter and competitors are required to undertake to compete in accordance with the Charter

3. Entries, Registration & Eligibility

- 3.1. The 2011 St Tudwal's Island Race and Gwyndaf Cup are an open events and entries are invited from PSC members and non-members.
- 3.2. The 2011 St Tudwal's Island Race and Gwyndaf Cup will provide racing for the following classes of yachts and the Class divisions will be as follows:-

Class	Flag	IRC – TCF - PYS - SBR
One	numeral pennant 1 (White with Red spot)	All IRC ISORA
Two	numeral pennant 2 (Blue with White spot)	All Classes (Non ISORA)
Three	numeral pennant 3 (Red, White and Blue vertical stripes)	
Five	numeral pennant 5 (Yellow and Blue halved vertically)	

- 3.3. These ranges may be changed at the discretion of the sailing committee
- 3.4. Class Flags will be flown from the backstay of each competing yacht.
- 3.5. Yachts shall belong to or be chartered to and be under the control of a member of a yacht club affiliated to the RYA or other equivalent national authority.
- 3.6. Entries shall be made on the Official Entry Form which is attached to this Notice of Race and this should be posted in the official race entry box located next to the official Notice Board in the entrance hallway of PSC.
- 3.7. The entry form must be accompanied with the appropriate entry fee and for IRC entries a copy of a valid IRC Certificate.
- 3.8. Entries will, in exceptional circumstances, be accepted, at the Race Officers discretion, by VHF for yachts arriving from other clubs.
- 3.9. The Race Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and/or to ask any boats to complete further undertaking or declarations before accepting their entry.
- 3.10. Yachts may enter both or either race. Entries for a single days racing may be accepted on that day.
- 3.11. Registration can be done at the PSC office. Race packs are available for printing from the PSC and web page. Printed copies are available from PSC on request to the Race Management Team.
- 3.12. Skippers are requested to provide, at the time of registration, a list of all the names of their crews. This request is made in order to comply with the clubs' licence obligations and Health & Safety.

4. Measurement

- 4.1. Valid and current IRC rating certificates must be presented with the race entry form.
- 4.2. Yachts that do not hold a valid IRC certificate may, at the request of the owner, be issued with a temporary TCF number to enter racing.

5. Changes in Sailing Instructions

5.1. Any change to Sailing Instructions will be posted by 09.30hrs on the day it will take effect and may be repeated on the Pwllheli Sailing Club Web Page.

6. Schedule of Races.

6.1. The race schedule will be as follows:

6.2. The type of racing on Saturday will be a long bay race and on Sunday the racing will be Windward Leeward style 'around the cans' based on fixed or variable courses. A schedule of marks, fixed courses and charts are provided in the PSC 2011 Race Pack available on the PSC web page.

7. Advertising

7.1. The series will be a Category C event.

7.2. All yachts may be presented with a sponsor's flag or decals, which must be displayed at all times.

8. Scoring System

8.1. Scoring will be in accordance with Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

9. Responsibility and Insurance

9.1. The safety of a yacht and its entire management, including insurance, shall be the sole and inescapable responsibility of the owner/skipper. Every owner warrants the suitability of his yacht for the Series. Yachts shall carry insurance protection for third party and passenger liability of not less than £2,000,000.

9.2. The organisers accept no liability whatsoever for loss, damage, death or personal injury of any description whatsoever that may be sustained by boats, owners, crews or guests taking part in this series of races using jetties, ramps, moorings, parking premises or any other facilities or using or accepting assistance from launches or boats by them or otherwise, however occasioned – whether by negligence of their members or servants or not.

10. Safety

10.1. IRC yachts shall comply with ORC safety regulations Category 4.

10.2. The Race Committee reserves the right to inspect any yacht to verify that the regulations have been complied with. Inspections will be carried out by Safety Equipment Advisers on behalf of the Race Committee

11. Personal Safety

11.1. RRS 1.2, 40 and E2 shall apply and it is the sole responsibility of the skipper to ensure that Life Jackets/Harness lines are carried for each member of the crew.

12. Safety Forms

12.1. Before the start of all races an Entry /Safety form giving the names of skippers and crew, their affiliation to the Club and contact telephone numbers, shall be given to the Race Officer. Failure to do so will result in disqualification

13. Prizes

13.1. Prizes will be awarded for the two races in each Class. The number of prizes will depend on the number of entries.

14. The Finish

14.1. First boat on water to telephone PSC Finisher on 07855706285 when estimate 60 minutes from Finish Line

14.2. Boats approaching the finish should contact "PSC Finisher" on Ch 17 when 30 minutes from the finish and again at 10 minutes from the finish. Please note that the finisher will only have a handheld radio and you may not receive an acknowledgment to the first contact.

After racing on Saturday - please contact the Race Officer (or text 07977929116) to say if you intend racing on Sunday. Please provide name of boat and yes or no.)
